Who is WAPA?

WAPA (Wireless Access Providers Association), established in 2006, is a non-profit trade association acting as a collective voice for the wireless industry. WAPA's primary objective is to promote the growth of broadband fixed wireless Internet access by facilitating self-regulation, promoting best practices, and educating both members and the market about new wireless technologies and business models.
